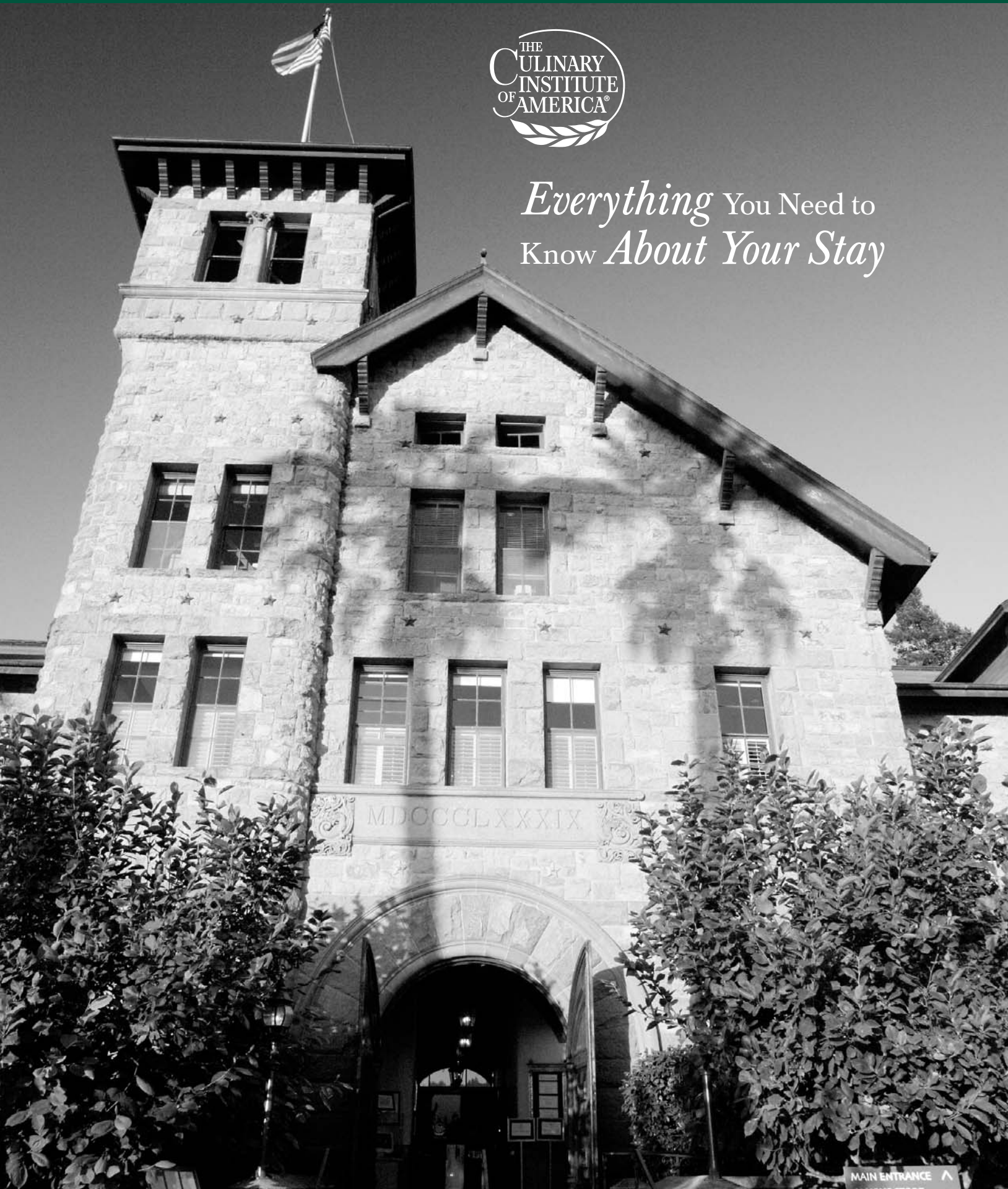

CONFIRMATION AND TUITION FEES

Please take a moment to review the enclosed course confirmation sheet, which details the date and time of your class.

On the first day of class, all students should proceed directly to the registration area in the Atrium on the first floor 30 minutes prior to the start of class. At that time, you will sign your enrollment agreement and pick up your name tag and course guide. Please remember that full payment is due prior to the start of your course.

ON-CAMPUS LODGING

If you have a confirmed reservation in the Guest House or Vineyard Lodge, check-in time is after 3 p.m. on the Sunday prior to your first day of class. Pick up your room key at the Security Station, located outside the building, to the right of the main entrance. See page 4 for more information.

CANCELLATIONS OR CHANGES

In the event that a course must be cancelled or the class time changed, you will be notified at least two weeks prior to the start of your course. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause, and we will make every effort to reschedule the course or make alternative arrangements for you.

ORIENTATION

On the first day of class, you will receive a course manual and name tag. The kitchen manager and your instructor will give you additional information during an orientation session about campus facilities, activities, and safety.

DE BAUN THEATRE

The 48-seat De Baun Theatre is the site of our daily cooking presentations—including demos and book signings by guest chefs. The theater is equipped with the capability to broadcast live to satellite and the Internet and produce live editing to videotape. It will also serve as a classroom for special lectures.

PROFESSIONAL WINE STUDIES

The Rudd Center for Professional Wine Studies is a multi-million-dollar, state-of-the-art facility created for the optimal study and evaluation of wine as well as wine and food pairing.

Students in wine classes should register on the first day of class in the atrium of the main building before reporting to class. Please plan to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to class time to pick up your course guide and name tag.

Students in the **Wedding Cakes and Advanced Cake Decorating** class should note the required specialized tools listed in the current *ProChef Quarterly*. **Career Discovery** students may borrow limited basic tools during their class.

For participants who do not have their own tools, a basic culinary or baking tool kit is available for purchase from our campus store, the Spice Islands Marketplace. You may preorder these by calling 707-967-2309 or toll free at 1-888-424-CHEF (2433). The store is open seven days a week from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

UNIFORM CODE

To foster a professional working environment and to maintain the highest standards of safety and sanitation, the CIA has adopted the following uniform code for **hands-on cooking or baking and pastry courses**:

- A uniform consisting of a white chef's jacket and chef's pants must be worn in production classes. Jewelry is not permitted except for one plain ring. Note: Chef's hat, apron, and a side towel will be provided for those in production courses.
- Shoes worn during food production courses should be made of firm leather, with no open toes or heels. Socks should be worn, and the wearing of nylon hosiery is prohibited.
- Hair should be neatly maintained, clean, and under control at all times. Long hair should be pinned up and worn under a hair net. Chef's hats will be provided upon arrival.

Career Discovery students who do not own a uniform should dress in black pants, white shirts, and black closed-toe shoes. A lab coat will be provided for use in the Teaching Kitchen. Uniforms may also be purchased at the Spice Islands Marketplace prior to class by calling 707-967-2309.

Dress code for students in **management and wine classes** is business-casual attire out of respect for the academic and professional atmosphere of the campus. Many wine classes include field trips to wineries and vineyards; plan to wear low-heeled, sturdy shoes and clothes suitable for cool mornings and hot afternoons. Your instructor will tell you about any planned field trips on your first day of class.

DIRECTIONS TO GREYSTONE FROM THE SAN FRANCISCO AIRPORT

BAY BRIDGE ROUTE: Follow the signs for Route 101 North. Take 101 North for approximately 11 miles. Follow the signs for I-80 to the Bay Bridge. Cross the Bay Bridge and go approximately 30 miles to the Carquinez Bridge. After the bridge, get in the right lane for about 2 miles. Take the Highway 37/Columbus Parkway exit and bear left up the ramp. Go west approximately 2 miles and turn right onto Highway 29 to Napa. Head northwest on Highway 29 for approximately 30 miles. Highway 29 and Main Street are the same within the city limits of St. Helena. The CIA at Greystone is approximately 2 miles north of the town of St. Helena on the left.

GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE ROUTE: Follow the signs for 101 North to San Francisco/I-380 & I-280. Take I-380 for approximately 1 mile, then follow the signs for I-280/Junipera Serra Freeway. Take I-280 North for approximately 6 miles, which will take you to Highway 1/19th Avenue to the Golden Gate Bridge. Follow the signs for the Golden Gate Bridge, approximately 7 miles. Once over the bridge, you will be on Highway 101 for about 20 miles. Take the Highway 37/Vallejo/Napa exit, then get in the left lane as you go approximately 7 miles. Take the Highway 121/Sonoma/Napa exit and go about 17 miles. Turn left on Highway 29 North and go approximately 20 miles to St. Helena. Highway 29 and Main Street are the same within the city limits of St. Helena. The CIA at Greystone is approximately 2 miles north of the town of St. Helena on the left.



TRANSPORTATION

BUS SERVICE: Evans Airport Service is a comfortable means of getting to the Napa Valley and will drive passengers from San Francisco and Oakland International Airports to the town of Napa. One-way fare is \$29 (cash only). Call 707-255-1559 or 1-800-428-5612, or visit www.evanstransportation.com. You do not have to reserve ahead of time.

Napa Valley Transit runs between Vallejo and Calistoga for \$2.50 and makes stops at American Canyon, Napa, Yountville, Oakville/Rutherford, and St. Helena. Call 1-800-696-6443 for the Napa Valley Rideline.

ACCOMMODATIONS

ON-CAMPUS SHORT-TERM HOUSING: A limited number of short-term housing units are available at Greystone's Guest House and Vineyard Lodge residence halls. Per-person weekly rates (up to six nights lodging) are as follows. **High Season (Apr. 2–Nov. 27):** Single Occupancy, \$840 per week; Double Occupancy, \$520.80 per week. **Low Season (Nov. 28–Apr. 1):** Single Occupancy, \$739.20 per week; Double Occupancy: \$470.40 per week. Rates include applicable hotel tax charges. Rooms are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis as available. Double occupancy rates apply only if a roommate can be arranged. Check-in time is after 3 p.m. on the Sunday prior to the first day of class.

OFF-CAMPUS SHORT-TERM HOUSING: Early reservations are recommended as Napa Valley lodging fills up quickly. Mention you will be attending a CIA course for a possible discount. 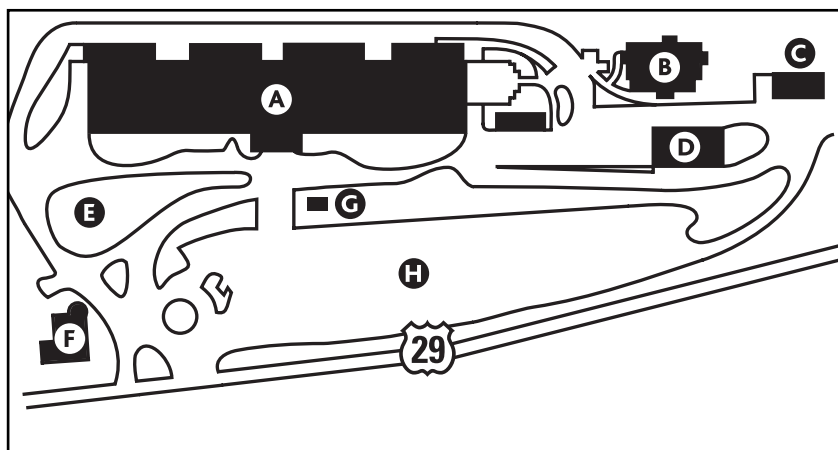
