

TUITION AND FEES

Tuition and fees at the CIA for the two-semester **Accelerated Culinary Arts Certificate Program** include instructional costs and required fees, and break down as follows:

FINANCIAL AID

Qualified students enrolling in Greystone's Accelerated Culinary Arts Certificate Program (ACAP) can apply for the Federal Stafford Loan and the Unsubsidized Federal Stafford Loan as well as Federal Work-Study and veterans' benefits. Parents of dependent students may apply for the Federal PLUS, and should contact their bank or lending institution for details.

The financial aid application process is administered by The Culinary Institute of America's Financial Aid Office in Hyde Park, NY. Interested applicants should submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. In conjunction with the FAFSA, some students may be asked to submit additional information. Call the Financial Aid Office at 845-451-1243 for more information.

Any member of the ACAP Deans Advisory Committee can nominate a program applicant for a \$2,000 merit-based scholarship by writing a letter of recommendation for him or her. For a full listing of the deans on this committee, please call 707-967-2497.

The Classic Residence by Hyatt Endowed Scholarship in the amount of \$5,000 is available to graduates of accredited undergraduate nutrition, dietetics, food science, or hospitality programs. All students accepted by May 1 will be considered for this scholarship based on academic records, extracurricular activities, and the personal essay provided with your application. Final selection will be made in consultation with Classic Residence by Hyatt.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND NOTIFICATION PROCESS

Applications may be submitted by May 1, 2008. Once you complete your admissions file (including an interview), the CIA will review your application and notify you within a few weeks regarding your admissions status. Admitted students are asked to confirm their acceptance by notifying the college. Confirmed students will be sent an Enrollment Agreement detailing their contract with the CIA, Notice of Eligibility, Fee Schedule, and other pertinent information. Space is limited for this program, so we encourage you to apply early.

Please remember to submit the following with your application materials:

- An essay of 400–500 words indicating what you want out of the program and describing your interest in/passion for food or the foodservice industry.
- All previous college transcript(s).
- Two letters of recommendation—one from the dean or director of the bachelor's degree program from which you will graduate or have graduated, and one from another professional who can speak to your interest in culinary arts training to support your career objectives. If it has been more than five years since your graduation from college, please provide a letter from your current employer in place of the letter from the dean or director of your college program.
